The Jhpiego Approach

Jhpiego collaborates with local ministries of health, nongovernmental organizations, public and private sector hospitals and clinics, schools, associations and communities to build sustainable local capacity to deliver services through advocacy, policy development, quality improvement and performance measurement approaches.

Jhpiego's program management strategy recognizes the technical complexity and geographical, cultural, socio-economic and political diversity among its programs. Jhpiego also develops innovative global program initiatives and technical interventions that can be adapted for country-specific applications. In support of this field-driven philosophy, Jhpiego uses a decentralized organizational structure that consists of a global "delivery system" designed to implement the entire portfolio of Jhpiego awards with assistance from key technical, programmatic and administrative staff.

Through the use of innovative approaches, Jhpiego puts research into practice and develops creative solutions to improve the health of women and families throughout the world. Jhpiego's focus on technical areas includes:

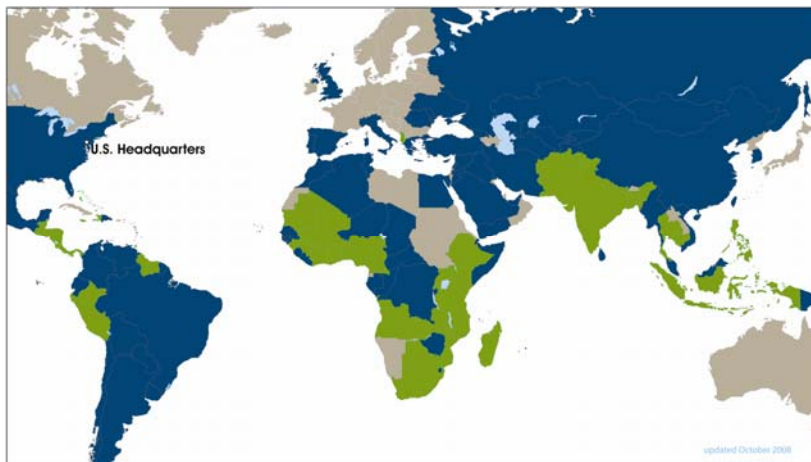
- Maternal and Child Health
