HIV and TB: Using the best science to save lives





Applying science to save lives worldwide

Since 2009, Jhpiego has targeted evidence-based approaches, such as index testing and HIV self-testing, to support 22,256,387 people to know their HIV status, including 622,552 people who were living with HIV. We've linked clients to the prevention and treatment services they need by providing:

- Antiretroviral therapy services for **229,613** people living with HIV, with **95%** viral load suppression among those with access to testing.
- TB preventive treatment for **69,856** people living with HIV (FY22 to date).

Scaling new interventions with fidelity

- Since 2003, Jhpiego has provided 5,476,433 men with access to safe voluntary medical male circumcision. We've served more clients than any other implementer.
- Since 2016, we've trailblazed implementation of pre-exposure prophylaxis for HIV prevention (PrEP) at scale, supporting 120,752 people to initiate PrEP. Now, we're piloting online and physical pharmacy models.
- Today, we're leading implementation science on the introduction of injectable PrEP and a PrEP vaginal ring.
- We are working on enhanced TB case finding, treatment, and prevention.

- As early adopters of design and demand approaches, we elevate clients as co-designers and decision-makers to offer equitable, respectful, empathetic services for all.
- Immersed in communities, our demand creation programs and services reach an intersection of underserved men, women, adolescents, children, and key and vulnerable populations in conflict settings and across sectors.

Frontier technology that promotes quality

- We use machine learning to predict which clients are likely to need enhanced support to stay on treatment.
- We analyze social media content to understand how the people we reach talk about health and health-seeking behaviors with neers
- We use software to search for in our data to ensure confidence in our data quality.
